

After School Dismissal Procedure

1. All students will be escorted to the gymnasium to be dismissed. This includes car riders, walkers and bus riders.
2. All car riders will be picked up behind the gymnasium only. We ask parents to be very cautious and slowly exit the pick-up line.
3. Each student/family will be assigned a car rider number. These numbers will be assigned a number through the main office. Siblings will be issued the same car rider number.
4. These numbers will be written on “bulldog bones” and distributed to parents. Parents will receive 2 bulldog bones per child/family. Additional or lost bulldog bones can be purchased for \$1.00 each.
5. Any car used to pick up students must have the bulldog bone clearly displayed on the right side dash or visor for safety purposes.
6. Students will not be released to cars who do not display their car rider number.
7. Walkers will be escorted outside from the gymnasium exit only. Walkers are to observe all crosswalks.
8. Bus riders will be supervised in the gymnasium until the high school bus arrives. Bus riders will then be escorted to the buses.
